Was established in 1963 with a technical assistance from FAO and UNDP under ministry of animal resources and fisheries. In 1993 the center was affiliated to IRCC under the supervision of the minister of industry.



Infrastructure :

- NLTC equipped with certified quality control & quality assurance laboratory ,pilot tannery and footwear ,leather goods section that serve Sudanese leather sector and academic institutions.
